From the North or South: Route 13 to Rt. 404 west near Bridgeville, DE. Follow Rt. 404 west approximately 14 miles to Route 16 west. Turn left on Route 16 west (towards Harmony and Preston) and follow approximately 1.4 miles to Detour Road. Turn left on Detour Road and follow 1/8 mile to 4-H park entrance on right. All trailer and vehicle parking is in grass field on right.

From the West: Route 50 east across the Bay Bridge to Route 404 east. Follow Route 404 east past Denton to Route 16 west. Turn right on Route 16 west (towards Harmony and Preston) and follow for approximately 1.4 miles to Detour Road. Turn left on Detour Road and follow 1/8 mile to 4-H park entrance on right. All trailer and vehicle parking is in grass field on right.
