A good discussion of options on how to get the library into circulation was had and it was decided that the first step was to have the contents of the library to be catalogued and culled of those items which are possibly unusable. Insurance Clarification by Pao Lin Hatch

Liability insurance is a tricky thing. It was made clear by one of our members that DDC's insurance is not panacea cure of all ills!

What does it cover?

Liability lawsuits by guests, Board of directors, Officers and members when a mishap occurs at either the DDC show, pleasure drives and or clinics.

What it does NOT cover:

Where the mishap or accident is YOUR fault? In that case, the DDC insurance would not cover your individual liability or fault.

More explanation?

Here's an example: You are at a DDC drive at a State park, your horse breaks loose, runs into a parked car and causes substantial damage to the parked car, another carriage or another equine. The owners of the car, carriage and other horse then sue the club for damages. Then under the general practice of tort litigation, they will name as many defendants as possible in the action. This may include other attendees of the drive, the State, the owner of the runaway horse and the DDC Board of Directors. DDC's insurance would protect the uninvolved attendees of the drive, the Club and the Board. **It would not protect the owner of the runaway nor the State Park.**

Hope that clarifies any misunderstanding of this complex area of the law!

George Parris made a proposal that the DDC maintain a smaller amount in our DDC avings account and support, donate, hold clinics and generate more activity in line with our DDC mission.
