A General Membership Meeting was held on December 3, 2022 at Hollvville Farm in conjunction with the DDC Christmas Party. The Treasury report showed a balance of \$11,131.67 (deposit of \$1,780 from the Hoppes-Addis Grant and \$100 withdrawal for cash for DDC merchandise sales). The report was accepted as presented. Make Your Life Easier with this Barn Hacks

With colder temperatures and wintry weather now upon us, here is a suggestion to keep your water trough from fully freezing. Naturally if you are able to have water heaters in your troughs, they obviously work best, but it never hurts to share tips and tricks to get thru the freezing months. Here's a trick to keeping water available to your horses with no power needed. Simply fill a milk jug or soda bottle half to three-quarters full of salt water and place it in the water trough. The jug will float and move the water around, plus, if the surface freezes, the horses will push the jugs down leaving an opening to get a drink! For large troughs you can put more than one jug. . You don't have to measure the salt, just place a good layer on the bottom of the jug add warm water, shake it up and place in the trough.


