





Best 'Barn Hacks'

Folding bike hangers (from Lowes or Home Depot) are a great way to manage multiple wet blankets.



Each horse has room for a rain sheet and heavier blanket. They stick out about 12 inches, so even in an entryway it's not too much. Blankets dried much better than folded over blanket bars or rods.



The bike hangers flip up when not needed.

Best 'Barn Hacks'



Here's and easy way to hookup your gooseneck trailer on the first back! Simply place a toilet plunger over the ball in the bed of the truck and back up. You can even paint the wooden handle of the plunger a bright color to be even more visible



Tired of spilling water on yourself in frigid weather carrying buckets of water? Put a garbage bag in your bucket, then fill it with water. Tie the top of the bag or use twine to close the bag—no more wet pants legs or boots! It's even handy to haul inside your trailer, on your four wheeler or gator!

Upcoming Events


